Precision Grafting Meets Dynamic Navigation: Advanced Techniques for Optimal Implant Success

Eduardo Nicolaievsky, DDS

Dr. Eduardo Nicolaievsky is a respected Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon and Implantologist with extensive experience in Mexico City and the United States. He earned his dental degree from the Universidad Tecnológica de México and completed residencies in Dental Anesthesiology and Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery at the University of Miami/Jackson Memorial Medical Center. Dr. Nicolaievsky served for many years as an Associate Professor at the Universidad Tecnológica de México and remains committed to advancing his expertise in oral surgery and dental implantology through emerging technologies and techniques.

He is a Fellow of the American Association of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, and Chief of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery Service at Mount Sinai Hospital in Miami Beach. In private practice since 1993, Dr. Nicolaievsky has authored numerous scientific articles and lectured internationally throughout Mexico, Central and South America, Europe, and the United States.

Updates in Anesthesia

Learning Objectives:

Deepak G. Krishnan, DDS, FACS, FDSRCPS

Dr. Deepak Krishnan is the chief of Oral Maxillofacial surgery at University of Cincinnati. He is an associate professor of Surgery at the College of Medicine at University of Cincinnati in Ohio, USA, where he teaches and practices.

Dr. Krishnan obtained his dental degree from Bangalore University, India and trained in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Emory University's College of Medicine in Atlanta, Georgia. Upon completion of the residency, Deepak pursued further fellowship training in Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery focusing on orthognathic surgery at Dalhousie University, Halifax, Canada.

He currently serves as the chair of the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons (AAOMS) Committee on Anesthesia (CAN) and serves on the Committee of Education and Training (CET) of the AAOMS as well as the special committee for Academic Mentorship for the AAOMS. He is a past-president of the Ohio State Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons and the current president of the Ohio Dental Society of Anesthesiology. He is a medical director for the Univ of Cincinnati Health system for their Ambulatory Surgery Center - Holmes Hospital.

RECERTIFICATION COURSE

Management of Medical and Airway Emergencies in the Dental Practice (OBEAM Equivalent)

The course will provide didactic, video, and case-based hands-on skills labs dealing with medical and airway emergencies possible in the dental and sedation settings. Participants will review, practice, and demonstrate proficiency in managing emergencies including, but not limited to, respiratory distress and failure, using bag mask, oral and nasal airways, perilaryngeal devices, as well as intubation and cricothyrotomy. Recognizing and treating emergencies such as cardiac events, stroke, syncope, seizures, allergic reactions, and laryngospasm will be reviewed and practiced.

This course meets the requirements for the Florida Board of Dentistry and AAOMS for office management and simulation has been endorsed as an equivalent program to the AAOMS National Simulation Program. Completion of this course fulfills the necessary simulation for AAOMS membership. Verification of compliance of successful anesthesia simulation training will be through the OAE program.

Meeting Attire

For this hands-on course, comfortable attire is recommended. Scrubs will not be required.

Shaun Fix has been practicing and teaching in the hospital and pre-hospital field since 1983. He is the president of Emergency Medical Consultants, Inc. and served 35 years as a company officer in charge of Emergency Medicine for Boca Raton Fire Rescue Services in the Palm Beach area of South Florida. Our team has been presenting Management of Office Emergencies for Dental Professionals since the 90's and along with Dental Specialty ACLS courses, helped present the original curriculum for the Dental Airway Course with members of the FSOMS board. Conferences and has appeared on FETN, Pulse, 24-7 EMS, Medic Monthly, and Emergency Medical Update videos. A frequent lecturer, author and consultant, Shaun and his group are best known for keeping their programs upbeat and relevant while bringing "the reality of emergency medicine" to the classroom setting and providing onsite relevant training based on the providers specific needs.
